Sub: Grant of recognition to the school from Class Ist to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. academic session 1993-94 for a day school (single shift).

Sir

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to grant recognition to your school from Class I to Class VIII (without aid) w.e.f. 1993-94 subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973 framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed and preference shall be given to the students of nearby area.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for all classes of the school as per the present norms of the Department.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Lab. as per the norms of the Department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ration of 10 Books per students may be added and facilities of reading room may also be provided immediately.
6. That adequate sports materials shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Sec.10 (1) of Delhi Education Act & Rules 1973.
8. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 Sq. ft. per student for the available area of the classroom and the school shall

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provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi, in each class. Number of existing sections should not exceed the number of class rooms of proper size in the school.

9. That the school shall not run any pre-primary and unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school, if any. No Branch of this school shall be run under the banner of the recognised school.
10. That the school shall disband with the services of unqualified and overaged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under rules 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provision of Rules 6, 7 & 9 be strictly observed.
13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the local body within a month.
14. That the management of the school shall create a reserve fund of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) in a joint account in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the School in any scheduled Bank.
15. That the violation of any instruction/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of the recognition of the school. That Class IX shall not be added to the School without the prior permission of the Director of Education, Delhi.
16. That no development fee shall be charged from the students.
17. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer every six month.
